AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Earlier request for pass over was made on behalf of counsel for the petitioner, Mr. Vikram Singh. Again request for pass over is made.

Perusal of various orders, which have been passed by this Court, would indicate that on the first date of hearing i.e. 20.02.2018, this Court had ordered counsel for the petitioner to place on record the grounds of appeal, which were filed before the Commissioner as well as the Financial Commissioner, Haryana. The said order has not been complied with on 23.03.2018, 02.04.2018 and 24.05.2018.

On 03.10.2018, last opportunity was granted by this Court to comply with the order dated 20.02.2018. On 11.12.2018, when the case was taken up, further time was sought by counsel for the petitioner to comply with the earlier order. The Court did not agree with the same. However, in

the interest of justice, another opportunity was granted to counsel for the petitioner subject to deposit of ₹1,000/- as costs with the Haryana State Legal Services Authority.

Today, the counsel, who had appeared for the petitioner, has stated that the costs have not been deposited and again request for an adjournment is made. Even order dated 20.02.2018, till date, has not been complied with.

In view of the above, the present writ petition stands dismissed for non-compliance of the orders passed by this Court referred to above.
