The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 58 dated 11.06.2019, registered under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148, 149 of the IPC at Police Station Sadar Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is attributed an injury which has been declared to be a simple injury and co-accused Sukhchain Singh, who is attributed injury falling under Section 326 IPC, has already been granted concession of regular bail by the trial Court, vide order dated 19.07.2019.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Charanjit Singh, has not disputed the factual position.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted concession of anticipatory bail subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It will be open for the Investigating Officer to serve a notice to the petitioner for joining the investigation, if it is so required.
