Reply by way of affidavit of Nar Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kalanwali, District Sirsa, filed in the Court, is taken on record.

Petitioner prays for bail in FIR No. 0007 dated 09.01.2015, under Section 25 of the Arms Act and Sections 148, 149, 285, 341, 307 and 427 IPC. Petitioner was granted bail, however, he jumped bail and did not appear before the learned Trial Court on 26.07.2018. As per the affidavit filed, petitioner was involved in as many as 9 criminal cases apart from the present one. He has been acquitted in 7 cases and convicted in one.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar has informed this Court that petitioner has also involved in another FIR lodged in December, 2018.

This Court has been informed that out of total 19 witnesses of the prosecution, 11 witnesses have already been examined whereas 2 have been summoned for tomorrow i.e. 27.09.2019.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is disposed of by directing the learned Trial Court to conclude the trial positively within a period of 3 months.
