1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the impugned order dated 21.08.2019 (P-1) whereby the request of the petitioner for grant of parole had been rejected by the respondents.

2. The petitioner was convicted and sentenced to undergo life imprisonment in case FIR No.544 dated 27.10.2013, under Section 201/302/364 IPC registered at Police Station Narnaund, District Hissar. Appeal filed by the petitioner against conviction and sentence is pending in this Court.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the conduct of the petitioner in jail is good and he had already availed the benefit of parole/furlough about 17 times. Present request of the petitioner for grant of parole to get her daughter admitted in Class III has been rejected by the Commissioner, Hissar Division, Hissar. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner has to arrange funds for admission, dress material, books and shoes etc.

The Commissioner, Hissar Division has gone by the opinion of

the District Magistrate, Hissar and while agreeing with him has declined the application for temporary release of the petitioner on the report of the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Narnaund that the daughter of the petitioner has already been admitted to School in Class III.

5. Having regard to the aforesaid report that the daughter of the petitioner has already been admitted in the school, I am of the view that no ground for interference is made out. There is no illegality or infirmity in the impugned order dated 21.08.2019 (P-1) passed by the Commissioner, Hissar Division, Hissar.

6. Dismissed accordingly.
