DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if the present petition is disposed of with the direction to the Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Guhla (for short – the Trial Court) to finally adjudicate upon the application filed by the petitioner under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC in a time bound manner as the petitioner/plaintiff has not been granted ad interim stay and that a delayed decision on his application filed under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC would adversely prejudice his rights.

The above prayer made by the petitioner is found to be reasonable and accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Trial Court to take a final decision on the petitioner's application under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC within six weeks from the next date fixed before it, of course after granting reasonable opportunity to the respondents to file their reply to the injunction application as also to argue their case.

If the respondents are aggrieved by passing of the present order they are at liberty to approach this Court by filing of an appropriate application.
