Counsel for the petitioners further states that the similarly situated persons, who were also not given the retiral benefits, had approached this Court by filing CWP No.15929 of 2018 and other connected cases, which have been disposed of by this Court keeping in view the statement made by the State of Punjab, with regard to assurance of payment to be released by concerned authority so that retirees, who have no other source of livelihood, may not suffer any more. Counsel for the petitioners prays that present writ petition may also be disposed of in same terms as CWP No.15929 of 2018.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that he has no objection in case the present writ petition is also disposed of in terms of the order passed by this Court in CWP No.15929 of 2018 and other connected cases, decided on 14.03.2019.

Keeping in view the request of counsel for the parties, the present writ petition is disposed of in terms of the order passed by this Court in CWP No.15929 of 2018 and other connected cases, decided on 14.03.2019.
