In the present writ petition, the grievance which is being raised by the petitioner is that for the treatment, which the wife of the petitioner underwent from 25.08.2014 till 29.08.2014, a sum of ₹4,63,770.51/- was incurred by him and the respondents are not reimbursing the same without any valid justification.

Counsel for the respondents on instructions from Dr. Kulbir Singh, Deputy Civil Surgeon, Karnal states that initially, there were some objections and after removing the objections, the bills had come to the office of the Director, Health Services, Government of Haryana and a sum of ₹40,000/- has been sanctioned in favour of the petitioner and bills have already been sent to the SDM, Karnal for releasing the payment.

Counsel for the petitioner states that out of ₹4,63,770.51/-,

approximately only 10% amount has been released and 90% amount has been withheld without any valid justification.

Counsel for the petitioner prays that he may be allowed to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause of action by challenging the order by which only ₹40,000/- has been sanctioned in favour of the petitioner as medical reimbursement though the petitioner was entitled for full reimbursement i.e. ₹4,63,770.51/-.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
