Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.18 dated 26.01.2019 under Sections 364, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 325 & 326 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after dismissal of his anticipatory bail application by this Court, the petitioner surrendered before the trial Court on 29.07.2019 and since then, he is in custody; challan stands presented and even the charges have been framed. It is further submitted that as per allegations in the FIR, the petitioner is attributed two iron rod blows on the right leg of the complainant.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Jiwan Singh and assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has not disputed the factual position that the charges have been framed, however, no evidence has been recorded.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the fact that petitioner is in custody since 29.07.2019 and is not involved in any other case and conclusion of the trial will take some time, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Petition is disposed of.
