Prayer is for grant of concession of regular bail in FIR No.174 dated 07.07.2018 registered under Sections 341, 365 and 323 of the Indian Penal Code (Sections 342, 34, 302 and 326 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 24/54/59 of the Arms Act were added lateron) at Police Station, Sarangpur, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 12.07.2018. Investigations are complete. Challan has been presented. Charges have been framed. The petitioner is attributed injury to the first informant and not the deceased with wooden batten.

On the other hand, learned counsel for UT Chandigarh, submits that the petitioner is involved in a heinous crime.

This Court has already considered various aspects while deciding Crl. Misc. No. M-61939-2018 on 26.08.2019 while granting concession of regular bail to the co-accused.

Keeping in view the facts of the present case, custody of the petitioner and the fact that the conclusion of the trial is likely to take time, it is considered appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail on

his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
