The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No. 156 dated 18.7.2019, registered under Sections 386, 342, 332, 506 and 120B IPC at Police Station Rama Mandi, Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case against the petitioner is totally concocted. Otherwise also, the challan has already been presented. Therefore, the petitioner is not required for any investigation purposes. The case was registered only in August 2019 and the trial is likely to take a long time.

On the other hand, learned counsel appearing for the State, being instructed by the police official present in Court, submits that the petitioner is part of a gang operating to black-mail people by giving threat of sexual allegations. However, it is not disputed that the petitioner is in custody since 19.7.2019 and that challan has already been presented.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon merits of the

case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner be released on bail on her furnishing bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
