As agreed, as per statement of the representatives of the Insurance Company and counsel for the appellant, (separately recorded today), a sum of ₹1,00,000/- (Rupees One lac only) more, over and above, the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant, keeping in view the young age of the appellant, who is a student of B.A. 3rd year and on account of the multiple injuries suffered by him and loss of future amenities and marriage prospect, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant the enhanced amount would be paid to the appellant.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of ₹1,00,000/- (Rupees One lac only) in the name of the appellant-Mandeep Kumar s/o Chander Bhan with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 02.07.2019 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. From the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.
