The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of appropriate direction to respondent No.2 to further direct respondent No.3 not to harass, humiliate and to make him sit in its office without any reason and further restraining respondent No.3 not to call the petitioner in its office without any complaint and further directing respondent No.3 not to act and interfere in the civil dispute on the best of respondents No.4 and 5.

This Court has already held in another petition i.e. CRM-M-20457 of 2019 decided on 06.05.2019, that unless the statutory proceedings have already been initiated by statutory authority or Court under Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, "Cr.P.C"), the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C is not maintainable for issuance of any direction. The remedy can be a writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternative remedy, in accordance with law.
