Petitioners have filed the instant petition seeking a mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect their life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondent No.4.

Petitioner No.1 is stated to be 19 years old and petitioner No.2 is 20 years old.

It is stated to be a live-in relationship.

Without commenting on the relationship/liaison between the parties and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent No.3, on the limited aspect as regards threat to their life.

In the eventuality of any such application, being submitted, respondent No.3 i.e. SHO Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar, would be obligated to look into the matter and thereafter to take steps as he may

deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
