Pursuant to the order dated 04.09.2019, this application, i.e., CRM-33375-2019, has been filed, seeking to place on record what is stated to be the medicolegal report as regards the injuries stated to have been sustained by petitioner No.2, Babita.

The application is allowed, subject to all just exceptions; from which it is seen that on 25.04.2019, she presented herself to the Civil Hospital, Ludhiana, with three injuries, as have been described in the MLR.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he would be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3, i.e., the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to duly protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.5 to 10, who are stated to be near relatives of the petitioners.

Without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, this petition is consequently disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to have the matter to be looked into by a Deputy Commissioner of Police, as regards the lives and liberty of the petitioners to be protected as per law.

If the Commissioner of Police/DCP finds that there is no merit in what the petitioners are contending, a detailed order giving reasons thereof will be passed by the Commissioner/Deputy Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
