The grievance of the petitioner is that the Collector had passed the order under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 [for short 'the Act'] *ex parte* against him against which he had filed an appeal taking this as a ground in the appeal but the Appellate Court did not take into consideration this aspect and dismissed the appeal as well.

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition in order to file a review at the first instance before the Commissioner on the ground that though it was argued before him that the petitioner was wrongly proceeded against *ex parte* but he did not decide the said issue.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
