1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner undergoing sentence of life imprisonment, for directing the respondents/State to grant him emergency parole to enable him to attend the bhog ceremony (*tervin*) of his late brother, who passed away on 28.08.2019.
2. Today Mr, Kapil Bansal, learned Law Officer submits that none is come present from the Department to impart instructions.
3. However, having heard learned counsel for the parties, I think that there cannot be any serious opposition to the prayer of the petitioner to attend the bhog ceremony (*tervin*) of his late brother on 10.09.2019.
4. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the respondents are directed to release the petitioner on emergency parole at about 2.00 PM on 09.09.2019 till 4.00 PM on 13.09.2019 to the satisfaction of the District Magistrate concerned, who is further directed to impose such conditions as may be required in the Jail Manual toward the ends of securing the presence of the petitioner in jail after the period of parole is over and done with.

5. Petition stands allowed accordingly.
6. A copy of the order be given to learned counsel for the petitioner under the signatures of the Bench Secretary.
