The petitioner is working as driver on daily wages for more than 18 years and his claim is to regularize his service from the date of regularization of his juniors i.e. 25.10.2011 (Annexure P-8) and further to restrain the respondents from terminating his service.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter-alia, contends that case of the petitioner is squarely covered by a decision of this Court rendered in CWP No.18356 of 2014 titled as “Lakhwinder Singh and another Vs. State of Punjab and others” decided on 16.04.2018.

3. The petitioner also caused issuance of a representation dated 05.07.2019 (Annexure P-11), but the same has not been adverted till date by the respondents.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On advance service of copy of the petition, Ms. Ambika Bedi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, appears on behalf of respondents.

6. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to

seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

7. Without commenting on the merits of case, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representation dated 05.07.2019 (Annexure P-11) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in this petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

8. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
