GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

The petitioner has approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.140 dated 12.10.2015 registered at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran, Punjab under Sections 498-A, 406 and 201 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 4.9.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Tarn Taran has been received, wherein it has been reported that statements of

petitioner/accused Sarabjit Singh and also of complainant Rajbir Kaur have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves with the intervention of respectables.

The complainant in her statement has stated that she has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.

The learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Tarn Taran has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.140 dated 12.10.2015 registered at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran, Punjab under Sections 498-A, 406 and 201 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioner.
