Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.145 dated 08.11.2017 under Section 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station GRP, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per allegations in the FIR, recovery of 24 injections of Buprenorphine 2ml each was effected from the petitioners. It is further submitted that as per the affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division GRP Amritsar, District Amritsar, total recovery is of 6.72 mgs/ml and therefore, this quantity will fall in the non-commercial quantity. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioners were earlier granted interim bail awaiting the FSL report and thereafter, they have surrendered back and have not misused the concession of bail. It is also submitted that the petitioners are in custody since 08.08.2019 and are not

involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of affidavit of DSP, Sub Division GRP Amritsar, District Amritsar filed in the Court today and on instructions from ASI Dharam Singh, has not disputed the factual position.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, this petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail subject to their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Petition is disposed of.
