Petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 553 dated 11.12.2017 registered under Sections 307, 506 and 34 of IPC, 1860 and 25 of Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Dharuhera, District Rewari.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has given a gun shot which hit on the left arm of the complainant. Now, the complainant has already been examined. The petitioner is in custody since 30.05.2018.

On the instructions from SI Naresh Kumar, learned State counsel has brought to the notice of this Court that out of 14 prosecution witnesses, only 7 witnesses have been examined.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the concerned learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
