Petitioners-Ravi Kumar, Kapil Kumar and Devi Chand @ Sachin have filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.274 dated 18.09.2018, registered at Police Station Mahesh Nagar, Ambala, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 341, 307, 506, 216, 120-B and 379-B of the IPC.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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As per the prosecution version, simple injury with iron pipe has been attributed to petitioner No.1-Ravi Kumar; injury under Section 326 of the IPC, which was given with axe on the right foot, has been attributed to petitioner No.2-Kapil Kumar and simple injury with iron pipe has been attributed to petitioner No.3-Devi Chand @ Sachin. In this case, no injury has been declared as dangerous to life.

The petitioners are stated to be in custody for more than 10 months. They are not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as they are in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping them in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
