The claimant is in appeal seeking enhancement of compensation on account of injuries sustained in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 29.07.2012.

The Tribunal awarded Rs.18,000/-, detailed hereunder:-

1. Medical expenses	Rs.8000/-
2. Hospitalisation, attendant charges, special diet and pain and sufferings	Rs.10,000/-

The Tribunal has noticed that as per treatment of Pushpa Devi, she sustained multiple and serious injuries all over her body and remained admitted in Johal Hospital, Jalandhar from 29.07.2012 to 30.07.2012. The treatment record and MLR of Pushpa Devi were not proved on record. Taking into consideration the materials on record, claimant is allowed additional sum of Rs.5000/- for conveyance charges and under head No.2 already allowed by the Tribunal. The same shall carry interest @ 7.5% per annum from the date of petition till realization.

The appeal is partly allowed in the aforesaid terms.
