On 19.09.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR No.40 dated 02.06.2019, registered under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, at Police Station Balianwali, District Bathinda.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Chaman Lal, has submitted that the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case of similar type.

Notice of motion for 04.11.2019.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.S.P.S.Tinna, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Let a copy of the petition be handed-over to the learned State counsel during the course of day.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

SI Chaman Lal, Investigating Officer present in Court, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and cooperated and he is not required for further custodial interrogation at this stage.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 19.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it is clarified that the petitioner shall continue to cooperate with the trial Court and shall not seek any unnecessary adjournment.

The petition stands disposed of.
