The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to register a case against respondents No.8 to 10 and to recover the son of the petitioner from their custody and further investigate the matter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on 24.8.2019, his son Deepak was kidnapped alongwith his vehicle 'Scooty' by one Gabbar Singh, who is an Inspector with the Punjab Police alongwith 15-20 unknown persons. According to him, the son of the petitioner had himself informed him the same telephonically. He submits that petitioner has given representation dated 27.8.2019 regarding the aforesaid occurrence to the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Panchkula as well as the Director General of Police, Punjab, wherein it is mentioned that numerous calls are being received by his another son Sandeep Kumar (brother of Deepak) on WhatsApp for payment of ransom. Learned counsel is unable to give the particulars of the alleged calls, at least the last call received by the petitioner

or his son Sandeep Kumar. He submits that necessary details regarding the alleged calls are missing in the representation and the relations between both of his sons are also not cordial. On a further query put to the learned counsel for the petitioner by the Court with regard to involvement of son of the petitioner in any criminal case, it was apprised that he is an accused, however, he is unable to furnish details.

Considering the above, this Court finds that the averments of the petition and the representation do not inspire confidence. Resultantly, no ground is made out to invoke the inherent powers of this Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Petition is dismissed.
