Petitioner, which is a sole proprietorship concern has filed the instant petition seeking a Mandamus for directing the official respondents under the Transport Department, State of Haryana to permit consultancy services and for the petitioner firm to provide services for registration of vehicles, route permits and transfer of the documentation etc. so as to help out the general public as also the clients.

Essentially the petitioner is wanting a stamp of approval to be an interface between the prospective applicant for a route permit or seeking registration of vehicles and the competent authority under the Transport Department.

The prayer made in the petition is not on the strength of any statutory provision or any other policy/executive instructions issued by the State Govt.

Under such circumstances, a Writ of Mandamus cannot be issued.

Confronted with a situation where this Court was not inclined to intervene, counsel prays for withdrawal of the instant petition.

Prayer is allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
