Counsel for the appellants prays for a short accommodation to file an application for impleading LR's of respondent No.2. The matter is pending since 14.11.2017 for the said purpose. There is no justification for allowing further opportunity for impleading LR's of respondent No.2. A relevant extract from order dated 14.09.2018, reads as follows:-

Counsel for the appellants has failed to comply with order dated 14.11.2017 till date.

Last opportunity is provided for the purpose failing which it may be of adverse consequence.

In view of the above, appeal against respondent No.2 fails and is dismissed. As appeal against respondent No.2, owner of the alleged offending vehicle has failed, nothing survives for consideration of this Court as application for compensation was ordered to be dismissed by the Tribunal.
