ARUN MONGA, J(ORAL)

1. *Inter alia*, issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* has been sought by the petitioner to quash order dated 27.08.2019(Annexure P-3), vide which the petitioner, who has been serving the respondents as Sub Inspector, has been repatriated from Punjab Police Academy Lines, Phillaur to his parent unit i.e. Ludhiana(Rural). It is stated that before completion of deputation period, he has been ordered to be repatriated.

2. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have perused the contents of the writ petition. I am of the view that no interference is called for in exercise of extra writ jurisdiction vested under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. Neither any violation of applicable provision of Act or Rules has been pleaded in the petition nor shown even otherwise in the course of arguments. On a query posed by the Court, no explanation, let alone a plausible one, has been rendered qua violation and/ or non-compliance of any provision.

3. In the premise, the writ petition is dismissed.
