The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.129 dated 05.06.2019, under Sections 323, 341, 342, 365, 379B, 384, 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Badhra, Tehsil and District Charkhi Dadri.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is an outomce of a misunderstanding between the petitioner and the complainant which has now been resolved with the intervention of the respectables. He also contends that the matter has been compromised and the petitioner had filed a petition bearing CRM-M-31037 of 2019 for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise and the statements of the parties have already been recorded in support of the compromise by the trial Court.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 04.09.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Shamsher Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation and not required for custodial interrogation, the order dated 04.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
