The instant writ petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus seeking directions to the respondents to re-fix the pay of the petitioner at par with his junior reserved category employee i.e. respondent No. 4 as per the government instructions dated 05.03.2009 and 23.11.2009 (Annexure P-9) and release of all consequential benefits including arrears etc. along with the interest without any further delay.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that similarly situated employees have been granted benefits as prayed for, by the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if time bound directions are given to respondent No. 2 to look into the legal notice dated 26.04.2019 (Annexure P-12) served by the petitioner in accordance with law.

Keeping in view the above said submissions, at this stage, interest of justice would be served in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 2-Director General & Commissioner of School Education to look into the legal notice dated 26.04.2019 and pass a speaking order expeditiously but not beyond two months. The necessary benefit may be extended to the petitioner in view of the order passed in ***CWP-19225-2012*** titled as '***Ramesh Kumar & others Vs. State of Haryana & others***, if found entitled to.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
