The instant writ petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant pay scale of ₹ 1400-2600 to the petitioners w.e.f. 01.01.1986 along with all the consequential benefits along with interest 18% per annum by removing the anomaly w.e.f. the date it arose.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has referred to the speaking order dated 09.04.2019 (Annexure P-5) and order dated 24.09.2015 passed by this Court in *CWP No. 2650-2000* titled as '**Rajinder Kumar Aggarwal & others Vs. State of Haryana and another**' (Annexure P-4) wherein pay scale of ₹ 1400-2600 w.e.f. 01.01.1986 was granted by the petitioners therein as per the notification dated 20.04.2001 who too were pharmacists.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have served a legal notice dated 19.05.2019 (Annexure P-7) for claiming the revised pay scales, being similarly situated on the petitioners in CWP-2650-2000.

Notice of motion.

On asking of Court, Mr. S.S. Pannu, DAG, Haryana who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. A copy of the same has already been supplied to him in the Court today.

Keeping in view the above said submissions, this Court is of the opinion that ends of justice would be served, if the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the respondents to look into the legal notice dated 19.05.2019 (Annexure P-7) and take a decision on the same after passing a speaking order, if found entitled to the benefit, within a time bound period but not beyond two months thereafter.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
