AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

Pursuant to the order passed yesterday, learned counsel for the petitioner has produced in Court today the orders passed by the trial Court on a few dates prior to the date on which the bail and surety bonds of the petitioner were cancelled, i.e. prior to 31.5.2019, showing that on 17.5.2019 an application seeking personal exemption had been moved which was allowed by that Court, with him also having been exempted from appearance on 26.4.2019.

Thereafter, after his bail and surety bonds were ordered to be cancelled on 31.5.2019, he neither surrendered on 18.6.2019 before that Court nor on 15.7.2019, with even non-bailable warrants issued to secure his presence not executed till 5.8.2019, leading to a proclamation being issued against him under Section 82 of the Cr.P.C.

Thereafter also he did not appear.

That being so, I see absolutely no ground to entertain this
petition.

Dismissed.

Naturally, upon the petitioner surrendering before the trial Court and filing any application for bail under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., that would be decided wholly on its own merits by that Court.
