Pursuant to the order dated 09.09.2019, the petitioner has brought four demand drafts in the name of the respondent-decree holder towards the instalments amounting to Rs.4,00,000/- out of the total amount of Rs.12,57,000/-. Photocopies of the said demand draft are retained on the record. The said demand drafts are handed over to the respondent who is present in Court alongwith her counsel.

Learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions from the son of the petitioner namely Mrinal Jain who is present in Court and is also an Advocate states that the balance amount shall be handed over before the Execution Court in equal instalments of Rs.80,000/- each to be paid every month on or before 15th date of every month by way of demand draft in the name of the respondent-decree holder.

In case the petitioner defaults with respect to any one of the instalment, the present revision petition shall stand dismissed and the respondent will be at liberty to proceed with the execution. The Execution

Court will not proceed further with its order unless petitioner defaults in making the payment as above. The Execution Court shall stand satisfied after the amount is paid as per the above directions.

It is, however, clarified that next instalment shall commence from January 2020.

Disposed of accordingly.
