The petitioner prays for concession of regular bail in FIR No.155 dated 04.12.2018, registered under Sections 379-B/411/323/34 IPC at Police Station E Division, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 04.12.2018. He further draws the attention of this Court to the statement of first informant-victim who has not identified the petitioner at the time of her deposition in the Court.

Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case and after keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, custody period of the petitioner and that the trial will take long time, it would be appropriate to direct the petitioner to be released on regular bail. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing adequate surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
