**Main Case**

The claimant is in appeal seeking enhancement of compensation on account of injuries sustained in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 29.07.2012.

The Tribunal awarded Rs.82,000/-, detailed hereunder:-

The Tribunal has noticed that as per treatment of Reema, she suffered fracture of backbone and six plates were affixed in her backbone. She remained admitted in Johal Hospital, Jalandhar from 29.07.2012 to 04.08.2012 and was referred to Satyam Hospital, Kapurthala. The indoor patient file showed that she suffered fracture of right radius, right galezzi and D12-L1 vertebra. She was operated with 6H plates with six screws. Taking into consideration the nature of injuries sustained coupled with period of hospitalisation, claimant is awarded additional amount of Rs.20,000/- for expenses on transportation and under head No.2 already

allowed by the Tribunal. The same shall carry interest @ 7.5% per annum from the date of petition till realization.

The appeal is partly allowed in the aforesaid terms.
