Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.706 dated 07.08.2019 under Sections 323, 406, 498-A, 506, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Karnal, District Karnal.

Vide order dated 06.09.2019, when learned counsel for the petitioner has offered for a settlement, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Accordingly, the parties have appeared before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre and settlement/agreement dated 09.12.2019 has been reduced into writing.

In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised

between the parties vide settlement/agreement dated 09.12.2019 before the

Mediator, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 06.09.2019, whereby arrested of the petitioner was stayed, is hereby made absolute.

The petitioner shall not be arrested in the case unless a clear 15 days' notice be given to him.

Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the parties will appear before learned Family Court, so as to file a joint petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act.

The parties shall adhere to the terms & conditions of the settlement/agreement dated 09.12.2019 in letter & spirit and they shall appear before learned Family Court, so as to file a joint petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act.

Disposed of accordingly.
