The five petitioners were appointed as Math/Social Mistresses after being selected on contract basis, pursuant to Advertisement dated 07.05.2011.

Their grievance is that they are being denied the benefit of regularization of their services with effect from 15.01.2016 in terms of the Regularization Policy dated 09.11.2016 (Annexure P-3) solely on the ground that their Graduation/Post Graduation degrees obtained through Distant Education Mode are not valid ones.

Additional affidavit filed on behalf of Assistant Director, (SA-2), Office of Director Public Instructions (SE) Punjab today in the Court is taken on record. As per the reply, in compliance with the order dated 02.04.2019 passed by this Court, the services of the petitioners have been regularised vide order dated 13.06.2019 as per conditions mentioned in the order.
