TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner is stated to be aged 20 years and has attained the age of majority. It is averred that the petitioner has got married to Satish Kumar on 12.08.2019.

A writ of mandamus is sought seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioner by asserting that the matrimonial alliance is not acceptable to her parents i.e. respondents No.4 and 5. Petitioner is currently stated to be staying with her maternal uncle as her husband is serving in the Indian Airforce and has resumed duty in the State of West Bengal on 25.08.2019.

Counsel submits that respondents No.4 and 5 have threatened the petitioner with dire consequences.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent No.3 confined to the aspect of threat perception that she has as regards her life

and liberty. In the eventuality of any such application being submitted, respondent No.3 would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and warranted in accordance with law.
