Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.29 dated 09.01.2017, under Section 174-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 05.09.2019, passed the following order:-

“ Contends that petitioner was granted bail by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist class on 10.01.2017 and he was regularly appearing before the learned trial Court. But on account of some communication gap with his counsel, he could not appear on 13.11.2017. Thus, non-appearance was not intentional but bonafide.

Notice of motion for 04.11.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned trial Court and in case of his doing

so, the learned trial Court would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to its satisfaction. ”

Today, ASI Neeraj Kumar submits that in pursuance of order dated 05.09.2019, petitioner has joined the proceedings before learned trial Court. Photocopy of order dated 17.09.2019, passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kurukshetra in this regard, is retained on file.

In view of above, interim order dated 05.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the learned trial Court and would not repeat such lapse(s) in future. Also directed that petitioner shall not seek unnecessary adjournments.

The observations may not be considered as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
