The contempt petition is filed pleading that directions of this Court issued on 24.4.2018 in CWP No. 9565 of 2018 are not being complied with by the respondents.

The facts in brief are that the petitioner filed a writ petition seeking directions to the respondents to release the pension and pensionary benefits along with interest. The petition was disposed of directing the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 30.5.2017 within two months and in case the petitioner was found entitled to the relief claimed, the same was to be released within 45 days. It was further directed that the case of the petitioner for grant of interest be also considered in view of the decision of the Full Bench of this Court in the case of **A. S. Randhawa v. State of**

Reply on behalf of respondent No. 4 filed in Court is taken on record, copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner. As per the pleadings, the pensionary benefits along with interest have been released to the petitioner. The details of cheque are duly mentioned in the reply.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that details of calculation of the retiral benefits and interest have not been provided.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 4 submits that details would be provided to the petitioner within six weeks from today.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of. However, in case there is grievance of the petitioner with regard to calculation of retiral benefits and interest, he would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.
