As per pleadings on record, the petitioners have worked with the Municipal Council, Nangal as Class IV employees (Safai Karamchari and Mali etc.) as outsourced employees through a contractor.

Prayer in the petition was for issuance of a writ of mandamus to direct the respondents to release their salaries for the period that they had discharged their duties and responsibilities.

Mr. H. K. Aurora, Advocate makes a statement that the salaries already stands released to the petitioners.

Such assertion is not rebutted by counsel representing the petitioners.

In view of the above, nothing survives in the instant writ petition and the same is disposed of as infructuous.
