The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 128 dated 11.08.2019, registered under Sections 306 and 34 of the IPC at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, Pardeep Kumar, brother of the complainant, was married with Parveen Kumari and Pardeep Kumar had a suspicion that the petitioner is having illicit relation with his wife Parveen Kumari and he committed suicide.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of the affidavit of SHO, PS-Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur, filed in Court today, submits that two of the co-accused, namely Gurpreet Kaur @ Reetu and Parveen Kumari @ Rani, stand arrested, however, Gurpreet Kaur @ Reetu has already been granted concession of regular bail.

In para 4 of the aforesaid affidavit, it is stated that on an application given by the petitioner and his wife Parminder Kaur to S.S.P.,

Hoshiarpur, alleging false implication in the present FIR, an inquiry has been marked to S.P. (D), Hoshiarpur and on completion of the said inquiry, the report shall be submitted before the Illaqua Magistrate.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed as this stage.

The petitioner is granted concession of anticipatory bail, subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer and conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

It will be open for the Investigating Officer to issue a notice in writing to the petitioner as and when he is required for investigation.

Liberty is also granted to the Investigating Officer to move an application for cancellation of anticipatory bail in case, in the inquiry, the petitioner is found involved in the present case.
