The widowed petitioner seeks a *mandamus* against respondents for her transfer from Government Dental College and Hospital, Patiala to Punjab Government Dental College and Hospital Amritsar, in accordance with the transfer policy, as her daughter is of marriageable age and the only son is studying at Amritsar.

2.) In the premise, the petitioner caused issuance of representations dated 22.07.2019 (Annexure P-2), 22.07.2019 (Annexure P-3), 16.08.2019 (Annexure P-5) and 16.08.2019 (Annexure P-6), but the same were not adverted by the respondents. Hence, the writ petition.

3.) Notice of motion.

4.) On advance service of copy of the petition, Ms. Ambika Bedi,

Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, appears on behalf of respondents-State

of Punjab.

5.) Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representations dated 22.07.2019 (Annexure P-2), 22.07.2019 (Annexure P-3), 16.08.2019 (Annexure P-5) and 16.08.2019 (Annexure P-6) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in this petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass appropriate order, in accordance with law.

7.) Let the needful be done within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
