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**AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J. (ORAL)**

In respect of his grievance, the petitioner is shown to have made a representation/complaint to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, on 07.12.2018 (copy Annexure P-1); though the land that is stated to be the bone of the contention falls in Village Talwandi Rai Dadu, Tehsil Ajnala, District Amritsar, and would appear to be falling within the jurisdiction of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural).

Civil litigation is also seen to be instituted at the Civil Court at Ajnala, as per the said representation/complaint itself.

Though the application has been filed before the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, since the dispute would appear to pertain to land falling within the jurisdiction of the SSP, Amritsar (Rural), this petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioner can approach the SSP, Amritsar (Rural), and if the subject matter is found to be within his jurisdiction, he shall hear the petitioner and take action if any is warranted, as per law, keeping of course in mind the fact that

civil litigation is already stated to be pending, though the allegation is that the signatures of some person (s) have been forged.

The petitioner would appear before the SSP Amritsar (Rural) within 10 days from today and upon him doing so, the SSP Amritsar (Rural), would pass appropriate orders within a period of 15 days, thereafter.

It is made absolutely clear however that this Court has not expressed any opinion as to whether the allegations made in the petition are correct or not.

The petition is disposed of.
