As agreed, as per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, learned counsel and representatives of the respondent – insurance company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹3,00,000/- (₹ Three Lac Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant as well as proforma respondent Nos.4 and 5 in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

The present appeal has been filed by one of the appellants i.e. widow of the deceased, however, parents of the deceased are proforma respondents. The MACT has given compensation to all the three appellants including the parents, who are proforma respondents here. As there is no contest between the widow and the parents of the deceased, 50% of the enhanced amount of compensation be paid to the appellant i.e. widow and the remaining 50% be paid to both the proforma respondent Nos.4 and 5 in equal shares.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the insurance company to deposit the enhanced amount of ₹3,00,000/- in the

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ratio as stated above in the name of the appellant as well as proforma respondent Nos.4 and 5 before the MACT concerned within two months, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
