Learned State counsel, on instructions from the police official who is present in Court today to assist him, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and it being a case of a version and cross version thereto, of the occurrence, the petitioner himself also having suffered five injuries, his custodial interrogation is not required.

That being so, the order 11.09.2019 is made absolute on the aforesaid statement made.

However, this order will not be treated to be an observation of this court on the merits of the case, but only in view of the fact that the investigating agency itself has stated that it does not require custodial interrogation of the petitioner.

Naturally, the complainant would be at liberty to avail of his remedy as legally available, as regards any grievance, including the investigation process.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
