The claimant is in appeal seeking enhancement of compensation on account of injuries sustained in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 04.07.2015.

The Tribunal has awarded Rs.3,37,614/-, detailed in para 36 of the award.

The sole submission made by counsel for the appellant is that compensation allowed by the Tribunal for pain and sufferings and special diet is on lower side. In addition, it is argued that the Tribunal has not allowed any compensation for transportation and services of an attendant.

The Tribunal has awarded a sum of Rs.10,000/- for pain and sufferings and special diet and another amount of Rs.12,500/- for stay in hospital. Compensation allowed by the Tribunal for stay in hospital can be appropriated towards transportation expenses and services of an attendant. In this manner, there is no justification for allowing compensation more than what has been assessed by the Tribunal.

For the foregoing reasons, finding no merit, the appeal fails and is accordingly dismissed in limine.
