Learned counsel for the appellant while praying for enhancement of compensation submits that no future loss towards income has been awarded. The temporary disability is stated to be 10% for which Rs.20,000/-has already been awarded by the Tribunal. Rs.12,000/-towards pain and suffering is inadequate.

Heard.

There is no permanent disability, thus, taking into account the hospitalization and other factors, this Court is of the opinion that the amount deserves to be enhanced by Rs. 10,000/-over and above the amount already granted towards pain and suffering.

The respondent is directed to pay the said amount with interest from the date of filing the claim petition, within a period of 4 weeks from today. However, in case the said amount is not deposited within time, the same shall be paid alongwith 12% interest till payment.

Disposed of accordingly.
