Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 5 not to initiate multiple enquiries at the instance of respondent No.6 and his family members.

During the pendency of this petition a First Information Report has been registered and the same has been placed on record. The complaint in the petition was against multiple enquiries and those have been deemed to be merged with the First Information Report.

In view of the above, the petition is dismissed. Needless to say that with the registration of the FIR, the interim order restraining the respondents for taking coercive action against the petitioner is not justified. Thus, the stay stands vacated.
