The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in FIR No.8 dated 22.01.2015 registered under Sections 399 and 402 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act at Police Station Balongi, District SAS Nagar.

It is pointed out by learned State Counsel that the evidence of the prosecution is almost complete. Only three witnesses are yet to be examined. The next date fixed before the trial Court is 08.01.2020. All the three witnesses shall be produced before the trial Court on the next date of hearing.

In view of the above, this Court does not consider it appropriate to interfere at this stage.

Dismissed.

However, if the prosecution fails to produce the above-said three witnesses on the next date of hearing, then the petitioner would be at liberty to apply for bail before the trial Court itself.
