INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.97 dated 08.06.2015, under Sections 323, 393 and 34 of the IPC, Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 and Section 304 of the IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Uchana.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that earlier, the petitioner was on regular bail. However, he absented himself from the court proceedings

on 08.07.2019 and his bail and surety bonds were cancelled and forfeited to the State. He himself surrendered before the court concerned on 31.07.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that absence of the petitioner from the court proceedings was not intentional.

The petitioner has been in custody since 31.07.2019. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
